New customers for O C E A N Telecine Controller

Geneva, Switzerland - Marquise Technologies announced today the installation of O C E A N Telecine controller at Refinery, in South Africa, and at VarioFilm in Switzerland.

Located in Johannesburg, Refinery is a famous film lab and post-production house well known for its work on motion pictures DI, as well as for commercials and TV series.

Refinery's film lab needed a solution to easily visualize and control the quality of the 35 mm developments, negative or IP rolls, before scanning the media for DI treatment in the post department. They decided to repurpose a first generation Millennium telecine in a Color Analyzer, thanks to O C E A N control and output capabilities: they are now able to identify the potential default in the image at a very early stage in the development process, what before was only possible with a film projection.

The film lab department can now also communicate with the DI more efficiently, with a tool able to compare and analyze the image. Refinery also uses O C E A N to transfers dailies to tape.

Variofilm, located in Lugano, Switzerland, is specialized in mastering old 16 and 35 mm film archives for the Swiss Italian Television. They have updated their telecine suite with a new Sondor Altra and O C E A N. Transfers are done in SD or HD resolutions and ingested in a Final Cut Pro, allowing the delivery of the content in ProRes.

"These two new client installations illustrate very well the versatility of O C E A N as a universal telecine controller, not only in terms of the variety of telecine supported, from DFT Spirit to Cintel Ursa, but also in the diversity of workflows permitted: film or commercial dailies, archives transfers or color analyzer, a whole world of possibilities that O C E A N can embrace effectively, easily and in real time", comments Laurence Stoll, CEO of Marquise Technologies.
